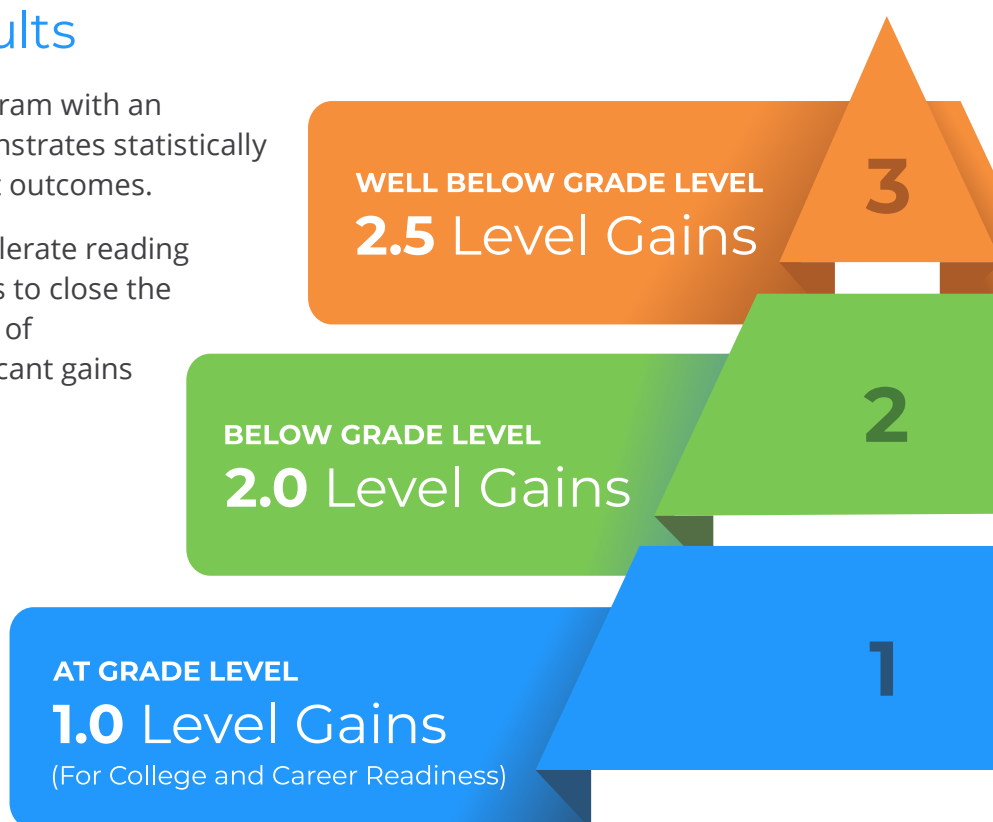
Research-Proven Results

Reading Plus is an evidence-based program with an extensive research portfolio that demonstrates statistically significant effects on improving student outcomes.

Reading Plus is designed to rapidly accelerate reading proficiency growth in struggling readers to close the achievement gap. In just 40 to 60 hours of Reading Plus use, students make significant gains toward grade-level reading proficiency.

The program begins with a 40-minute adaptive online assessment that provides an individualized diagnostic profile and personalized instruction path for each student. Printable resources, supplemental materials, and integrated teaching tools—including video tutorials, printable worksheets, graphic organizers, and lesson plans—support teacher-directed instruction and differentiation.
